





Final Tally: 312 applications requesting \$1,542,200, including:

148 Category 1 grants requesting \$393,639 (expected awards - 75)

53 Category 2 grants requesting \$942,261 (expected awards 5- 6)

111 Category 3 grants requesting \$206,300 (expected awards 65 awards)
